1. Background and Objectives

The appointed firm will be expected to study the social impact and land use impact from the implementation of the KL–SG HSR project within Malaysia, as part of the project's regulatory requirements.

2. Who can Participate in the Tender

- (b) The individual consultant from the firms who participate in this tender must be registered with the Malaysia Association of Social Impact Assessment ('MSIA') or Malaysia Institute of Planner ('MIP') or National Heritage Department ('NHD'); and



(c) Firms with the experience in preparation and submission of SIA for the railway projects or any linear projects in Malaysia.

* Firms that are currently involved in HSR-related services or assignments with MyHSR Corp should confirm their eligibility with MyHSR Corp.
